Date	Rank	Breach	Outcome
04.01.12	Constable	<p>It was alleged that the officer presented herself for duty in an unfit state to carry out her responsibilities due to the effects of alcohol.</p> <p>The officer drove a motor vehicle after having consumed alcohol in excess of the permitted limit.</p> <p>The officer appeared at court and pleaded guilty for driving with excess alcohol.</p>	Resigned whilst under investigation.
24.01.12	Constable	<p>It is alleged that the officer engaged in an inappropriate sexual relationship with a vulnerable female.</p> <p>It is alleged that, other than in the course of their duties, the officer accessed and viewed confidential information on police computer systems which was not for a lawful policing purpose.</p> <p>It was alleged that on numerous occasions whilst on duty the officer provided monies to a vulnerable female in order for her to purchase controlled drugs which they then shared.</p> <p>It is also alleged that the officer failed in their duty as a police officer to intervene or report a criminal offence committed by another officer, namely that the officer was present when the other officer provided monies to a vulnerable female in order for her to purchase controlled drugs which she then gave to the officer.</p> <p>The officer was convicted of 3 counts of misconduct in a public office and 3 counts of breach of Data.</p>	Resigned whilst under investigation.
29.05.12	Constable	<p>It was alleged that while off duty at a nightclub the officer was arrested on suspicion of possession of a Class A controlled drug.</p>	Resigned whilst under investigation.

29.05.12	Special Constable	It was alleged that the officer accessed a Police intelligence system and completed searches that were not for a policing purpose.	Resigned whilst under investigation.
26.06.12	Special Constable	It was alleged that the officer had entered a course of conduct during which they groomed a 13 year old female for sexual activity. As part of this conduct the officer sent indecent images of themselves via a telecommunications device.	Resigned whilst under investigation.
19.09.12	Sergeant	It was alleged that the officer was responsible for a Common Assault on their estranged wife; who in a statement to police alleged that the officer was a drug user and was concerned in the supply of Controlled Drugs.	Resigned whilst under investigation.
22.11.12	Constable	It was alleged that whilst assigned to guard the scene of a murder, the officer compromised the scene by entering the scene and without lawful authority took a photograph of the deceased person on their personal mobile telephone for a purpose unconnected with their duties and which was not a lawful policing purpose. Having done so, the officer, showed this image to a colleague and subsequently made a false statement to a supervisor when challenged.	Resigned whilst under investigation
13.12.12	Constable	Gross Misconduct in respect of Honesty and Integrity, Discreditable Conduct – The officer was dishonest about their involvement in respect of an incident and attempted to influence a colleague to give false evidence, thereby bringing discredit to the Police service. Misconduct Hearing held.	Dismissed without notice.
