16.01.14	Special Constable	It was alleged that the officer unlawfully acquired a quantity of scratch cards and claimed subsequent winnings.	Resigned whilst under investigation.
22.01.14	Constable	<p>It was alleged that the officer had on numerous occasions accessed police systems and viewed sensitive personal data in respect of several individuals, including themselves, for a non-policing purpose.</p> <p>It was also alleged that the officer had failed to disclose a disclose-able association in respect of one of the above mentioned individuals.</p>	Resigned whilst under investigation.
20.03.14	Constable	<p>The officer having seized property, failed to follow force policy and procedures. The officer dishonestly appropriated the property for their own use, thereby bringing discredit to the Police Service.</p> <p>Misconduct Hearing held – Gross Misconduct in respect of Honesty and Integrity, Orders and Instructions, and Discreditable Conduct.</p>	Dismissed without notice.
20.03.14	Constable	The officer having seized property, failed to follow force policy and procedures. The officer dishonestly appropriated the property for their own use, thereby bringing discredit to the Police Service.	Dismissed without notice.

06.06.14	Constable	<p>It is alleged that on a number of occasions the officer accessed and viewed confidential information on police systems, otherwise than in the course of their duties and which were not for a lawful policing purpose.</p> <p>It is alleged that the officer submitted a report to a supervisor regarding their access to a crime report, which the officer knew to be false, misleading or inaccurate.</p>	Retired whilst under investigation.
31.10.14	Constable	<p>It was alleged that the officer was not conscientious and diligent in the performance of their duties and that they neglected their responsibilities when dealing with a report of domestic assault.</p> <p>It was also alleged that having been instructed by a supervisor to record a crime they failed to comply with a lawful order.</p>	Resigned whilst under investigation.
05.11.14	Special Constable	<p>It was alleged that the officer was not open and truthful in their dealings and that they knowingly made false, misleading and inaccurate statements to officers of another force concerning their relationship with a Registered Sex Offender, which they knew to be false.
