The key priorities for Policing in Derbyshire were reassessed at the Strategic Tasking & Coordination Group on November 9, 2016, chaired by ACC McWilliam. A total of 13 areas were assessed through the MoRiLE process (Management of Risk in Law Enforcement) in terms of the risk and threat they pose to the communities of Derbyshire.

As a result, the priorities set for the forthcoming strategic period are as follows:

- Serious Acquisitive Crime
- Domestic Abuse
- OCGs (Organised Crime Groups)
- OICHTE (Organised Immigration Crime, Human Trafficking & Exploitation)
- Rape & Serious Sexual Assault
- Safeguarding Adults
- Safeguarding Children
- Substance Misuse
- Terrorism & Domestic Extremism
- Cyber Crime
- Anti-social Behaviour
- Economic Crime
- Killed & Seriously Injured Road Collisions

These priorities will be addressed as equal priorities, not in rank order. They will continue to have a force lead and an action plan and will be the main focus of NIM tasking processes throughout the force.
