Derbyshire Alert is an online, secure messaging service that allows the force, Neighbourhood Watch and other key partners to distribute messages concerning local crimes, community safety to the public quickly and effectively.

Alerts are mainly sent by email but people can choose to receive them via text or a voice message. It is designed so users who sign up to the system can choose what information they receive, how often they receive it and in what format.
