the wars and conflicts that have followed and that is why this year we will include two tributes to the aforementioned. **Saturday the 12th of July** will involve the specially written Memorial Service recognising the onset of WW1. This poignant service will take place on Poolsbrook Country Park S43 3WL following a parade from Staveley Market place starting at 1000.

In the van of the Parade will be the Corps of Drums and Marching Band of the

Yorkshire British Legion and Standard bearers.

The Lord Lieutenant of Derbyshire and other notable Dignitaries will lead the remainder of the Parade to the event site. Here Royal British Legion Padres will conduct the Service with input from The Lord Lieutenant and Civic Dignitaries.

The event will then be officially opened.

A short parade along Pavilion Drive S43 3WL at 1000 led by John Best the Lone Piper, Standards, the Mayor of Chesterfield and Civic Dignitaries will precede our

second Service Tribute on **Sunday 13th July**. This will again be conducted by Royal British Legion Padres supported by the Mayor of Chesterfield and other dignitaries.

The Ireland Colliery Chesterfield Band will accompany the Service.

The second day of the event will then be officially opened.

Our annual tribute to the Military and Civilian services complements Chesterfield's affiliation to and support of these personnel.

The event also emphasises the privileges and freedom that are defended by them for us
