



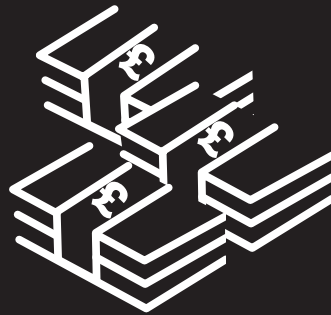
Be wary of using public Wi-Fi on a business laptop or device, and always turn your Wi-Fi off completely when you're not using it.
